

TO JUDGE OR NOT TO JUDGE

A grocery store checkout clerk once wrote to advice columnist Ann Landers to complain that she had seen people buy "luxury" food items - like birthday cakes and bags of shrimp



A few weeks later, Landers' column was devoted entirely to people who had responded to the grocery clerk. One woman wrote:

> I didn't buy a cake, but I did buy a big bag of shrimp with food stamps. So what? My husband had been working at a plant for fifteen years when it shut down. The shrimp casserole I made was for our wedding anniver sary dinner and lasted three days. Perhaps the grocery clerk with her criticisms would have a different view of life after walking a mile in my shoes.

Another woman wrote:

I'm the woman who bought the \$17 cake and paid for it with food stamps. I thought the checkout woman in the store would burn a hole through me with her eyes. What she didn't know is the cake was for my little girl's birthday. It will be her last. She has bone cancer and will probably be gone within six to eight months.

An American Indian proverb, paraphrased, says: "Never judge a man until you have walked a mile in his moccasins". So hold on to your judgment. You do not know the heart or even the circumstances surrounding an action, though it may seem so obviously wrong. And that is why only God can judge because He alone knows the motives of the heart. And Jesus Himself says: "Judge not that ye be not judged." Matthew 7:1
