A TRUE FRIEND

Proverbs 17:17 defines a friend as one who "loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity." But what do you do when your friend falls into disfavor in the church and every-

body tries to avoid him because of sin or is perceived to have sinned? Do you still love him, or would you abandon him?

Our Savior hates sin but He loves sinners. And one of the most difficult tasks we as Christians are asked to do is to love a sinner while at the same time hate his sin. This is hard to do unless we have Christ's love in our hearts. Christ is our example and we are to follow Him.

When your friend is down and out, don't turn your back on him or deprive him of your uplifting Christ like influence.

The best picture ever portrayed of a true friend is the one that says: "A friend is one who walks in when the whole world walks out." A story is told of Chuck Colson who spent time in prison for his part in the Watergate debacle. When he got out of prison, he wrote a book "Born Again." In this book he narrated a story of his experience with many encounters with students on various University campus lectures.

Students hated Nixon and everybody associated with Nixon and so he was bombarded with many pointed and vitriolic questions. One student stood up and read Henry Kissinger's criticism of Nixon. Then he asked: "Mr. Colson, do you agree with Kissinger's criticism of Nixon?"

Colson replied: "Mr. Nixon's negative traits of character has been dissected more than anybody I know and it is almost universally known that I don't see any need to add to what has already been made public. Mr. Nixon is my friend and I don't turn my back on my friend.

Mr. Colson was given a standing ovation even by those who hated him and Mr. Nixon. Nobody likes anybody who turns their back on their friend.

The best friend you can ever have is JESUS. He is a true Friend. He never turns His back on you.
