Neighbors spoke kindly and fondly of her and remembered her many loving deeds. One recipient of her kindness referred to her home as the DSW (Department of Social Welfare) Center of the community.

The Apostle John in writing the book of Revelation says: "Blessed are those that die in the Lord; yea says the Spirit. For they rest from their labors and their good works do follow them" (14:13).

And we look to that day when Jesus shall come and all the angels with Him. The dead in Christ will be raised back to life and we shall join them again "in the land of fadeless day."
